### THE STORY

### **OBJECTIVE**

With the aim of creating a new headquarters that would support the rapid growth of their company, this Chicago-based real estate firm partnered with Rightsize to create a functional and innovative space that would reflect their brand.

### **DESIGN SOLUTION**

Essex was very intentional in their choices and motivation. Previous iterations of their office consisted of refurbished pieces, as this was their first build out involving new selections. With a goal of bringing warmth to this industrial space, the aesthetic choices highlighted the tall ceilings, while divided-light windows help to provide a modern, naturally lit space. Special attention was given to the break room/lounge area. This was an important space that needed to feel welcoming, and comfortable while also being flexible for hosting large meetings.

### **DESIRED OUTCOME**

The design intent for all furniture was to have a more residential or elevated feel rather than look like a commercial office. We achieved this with the materials/finish selections, and by layering in accessories such as area rugs, pillows, plants and decorative lighting.
